Essay 1: The first essay should be 2 double-spaced pages outlining on How Being a Pagan has changed your life

Essay 2: This one's a little more involved. We'll need 3 Page typed, double-spaced, MLA-formatted pages on the scholarly topic of your choosing. The point here is to show that, given sufficient motivation, you can do well!

It probably goes without saying, but plagiarism will remove you from consideration now and in the future.

High School Transcripts

3 Letters of Reference current (less than 6 months old) letters of recommendation from teacher, Pagan clergy or persons other than family members who are familiar with the applicant's skills and abilities

Name of College or University where enrolled. Letter of acceptance, and class registration 9 Credits Minimum (Check will be mailed in your name and schools) *It is Understood that you may not have all this information by April 1st from the college*

Ability to Attend The Award Ceremony

All Requirements must be submitted by April 1st We will not take late applications or incomplete applications
